

# Group Visits: Weavers' Triangle

The Weavers' Triangle is one of the finest examples of a Victorian industrial landscape in the country, your visit can include a walk along the banks of the canal through this townscape and a guided tour of the visitor centre which is located in the wharfmaster's house and canal toll office. The centre explains all about the cotton industry and the construction of the Burnley section of the Leeds and Liverpool Canal, with period rooms giving you a taste of how people lived in the Victorian age. You can also include a visit Oak Mount Mill Engine house a short walk along the towpath.
