Gawthorpe Hall

Gawthorpe Hall is a Jacobean Manor House set in a green oasis of woodland and pasture on the banks of the River Calder. This National Trust property is home to the Rachel Kay-Shuttleworth collections of lace, embroidery and costumes, has Civil War connections and was visited several times by Charlotte Bronte who was a friend of the Kay-Shuttleworth family. Lunch will be served in the tea-rooms next to the hall, and then you will have a chance to look around this elegant home.



3.30pm

Foulridge Canal Cruises

The day finishes with a boat trip along the Leeds and Liverpool Canal in the Marton Emperor, a 48-seater canal cruise boat operated by Foulridge Canal Cruises. This relaxing journey on one of the highest and most scenic stretches of the canal will take you through the Pendle countryside towards the village of Salterforth. Tea and biscuits will be served on your journey or you can purchase something stronger from the bar if you prefer.
